Nothing much is the short answer; we've always taken a strong line with the way your data with us is handled. We've added a GDPR page into version 3 of the application which summarises the care we take with your data and we'll be making the aggregated export of your data simpler so that you don't need to go to different pages to do it.

### Simply put

- We have audited and, where appropriate, updated our internal policies in order that they are compliant with the requirements of GDPR and our own company values.
- To support your right to data portability, you will have access to a simplified download function. You can download all information currently but we will make this simpler.
- We will now formally ask you if we are allowed to access your record when you ask us for help.
- We have strengthened our policy on password resets and these now will only be processed through the password reset function and not over the telephone or via email.
- We have introduced a GDPR page into version 3 of Standards Tracker. This includes simple information about how we collect, manage and secure information. This page also includes a 'record access summary' tool which lets you know who can see your record.
- Version 1 users can access our GDPR documentation in the PM Guidance area of Standards Tracker.
- If your organisation elects to no longer use Standards Tracker, it will be able to elect to archive or delete the account. Where deletion is requested, all data will be permanently deleted and will not be recoverable. You will be alerted to any changes in the active status of your organisation's account.
- We have audited data flows within Standards Tracker.
- We have reviewed our use of third party software tools and satisfied ourselves that they meet our technical and GDPR requirements.
